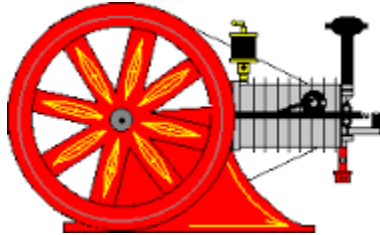

The July 12th meeting was held at the SHED!

President, Chuck Klim, called the meeting to order, followed by the flag salute. The minutes were read from last month's meeting by Secretary, Sandy Betts. Treasurer, Linda Klim, reported general account and raffle account balances. Linda referenced the balance differences, that are due to last month's report of raffle expense paid out from the general account...now rectified. Outstanding bills to be paid were reviewed. Bob Triebel's expenses for the newsletter, \$156.34 and Bill Castimore's expenses for sign reprinting, \$25.59 and \$42.00 were approved for payment. The Treasurer's minutes were now approved.

OLD NEWS: The trailer sign lost after the Branchville parade was returned to shed by a "good Samaritan" and the parade around Skylands ballpark field on June 17th was also a success...see PAGE 5 of the newsletter.

NEW BUSINESS: The next Club meeting will be Saturday July 23rd at 7:00. A review of the operation of the cash register along with shed cleanup will be performed prior to meeting. Also, the removal of the tree (next to the shed) is planned for Sunday, July 24th. Brian Kardos is checking on lift truck availability and the cost of possibly renting one is \$300...which was approved by the membership at the meeting.

Rich Muys and Chuck Klim will pick up peanuts in the week prior to the FAIR.

Members must sign in on the schedule when working at the fair. For insurance reasons this is necessary. It was also addressed that more members are needed in particular for the evening/closing shift. We will change from 3 shifts daily to 4 and hopefully more members will volunteer!

The plans for the shed addition were discussed: a \$15,000.00 government project grant to fund the addition might want to be rethought at a higher amount to include any additional costs. Discussion was made regarding the fact the shed addition was going to be used to store tractors and the Club does not own any tractors...making the grant difficult. Chuck thought of a workaround in displaying boat motors we already have. Receiving grant monies could take approximately 3 to 4 months. Looking for a sponsor or sponsors was also mentioned as that could be used for additional costs and ongoing projects.

Linda Klim spoke of selling plants, flags, bird houses, hats and assorted items along with cookies and brownies at the counter. Linda has a food handling license to cover those transactions. There was talk of having a prepared spreadsheet of these items so a record could be kept of quantities sold. Linda also stated there will be several signs inside and outside showing pricing.

Badges for the fair were handed out. Those who still need a badge picture can still do so between 9 am and 4 pm.

The Clubs daily tractor/cart parade will be increased this year to twice a day...two laps at 2:00 pm and another two laps at 5:00 pm. The club did well last year in receiving donations during the parade so adding a second lap would also help with the cash flow.

Justin Filipowski, of *Fosterfields Historic Farm*, discussed the Saturday, September 10th event. Called: "Antique Tractor Day", it will be advertised in the *Morris Tourism Journal* and elsewhere. They would appreciate a months notice on how many members will participate, what will be displayed and how many will be plowing.

The motion was made by Richard Muys Sr. to adjourn the meeting and 2nd by Adrianna Muys.

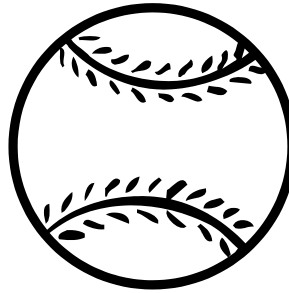

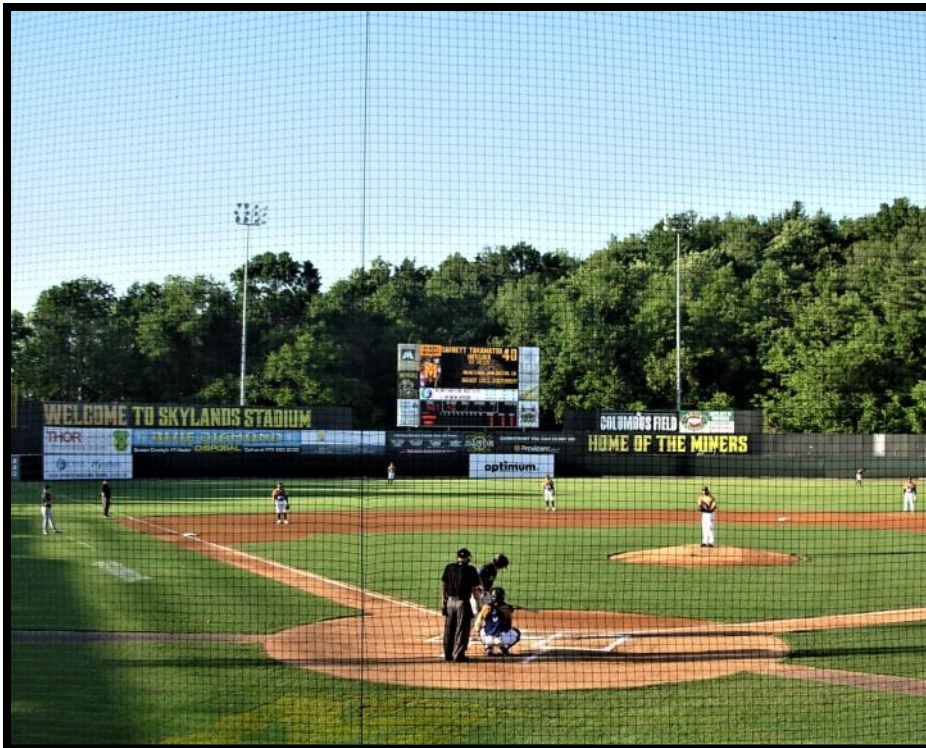
