

The July 11th 2023 NJAE&MC INC. meeting was held at the SHED!

President, Chuck Klim, called the meeting to order, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Minutes were read from the last meeting by Secretary Sandy Betts

Treasurer, Linda Klim reported the general bank account and raffle account balances. Bills requiring payment were \$120.83 to Bob Triebel for the club newsletter. Additional bills were to Lowes for \$52.25; Home Depot \$33.86 and Newton Trophy \$33.59 for 2 plaques. Bills already paid were \$55 for *The Hardware Store* cart sign; \$16.98 for water; \$178.00 for the shed construction permit; \$35.00 zoning permit; \$200 to Barbara Thomas for the STATE FAIR quilt (paid from the raffle account); \$3,375.05 including the discount and donation from and to Kuiken Brothers; and \$1,200.71 to Northwest Building Supplies.

The brooms purchased to sell during the fair will be returned, as the quality was not satisfactory. The company was contacted, and they will replace them. Peanuts must also be picked up prior to the FAIR. The peanut vendor was contacted and agreed to sell for the same price as the last few years. The cost should be approximately \$1200 and they should last the club through December events.

Linda Klim is "donating" two more American girl dolls to be added to the one that we originally purchased. This will increase the number of items to be offered in the Club raffle and increase the value by at least \$400.00.

Club shirts are being embroidered and will be ready in a couple weeks.

FAIR passes will be available through Linda when provided by the FAIR.

The Treasurers' report and all payments were approval by the members at the meeting.

Per Chuck, a project day(s) will be required prior to the fair to uncover, service, start and repair the engines to make sure everything is in working order. It was suggested this might be a good time to begin doing videos on the maintenance and history of these engines. If a list can be provided, Andy Martin offered his time to research any of the engines in preparation of these videos. An email will be sent to members when the day and time for the project or projects are established.

Steve Boutillette discussed the Clubs website and difficulties that have arisen. The domain registration had expired, and Steve was not notified...he is working on getting it reinstated and it should be functional shortly. He had been maintaining the site, adding information and events as it was forwarded to him.

Difficulties with Facebook had also been discussed, as that had been set up by Kevin Adams making it difficult to edit or add information. Kevin has not attended Club meetings for quite a while so this has created a problem.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Martin Little and seconded by Dick Haskins.
