

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

A reminder that the Club has been asked to participate at Skylands Ballpark on Friday June17th. It was asked that members assemble at 4:30 by the sphere to set up for the parade around the outfield track of the ball field.

Members must sign in on the schedule when working at the State Fair in August. For <u>insurance reasons</u> this is necessary. It was also addressed that more members are needed...in particular for the evening/closing third shift.

The plans for the shed addition were submitted to the Fairgrounds Board on May 19th and approved. Chuck had estimated the cost to be approximately \$9,000.00 for materials only. It was discussed applying for a \$15,000.00 government grant to fund the addition. The club also received permission to remove the tree by the big Oil Field Engine. Brian Kardos is working on arranging for a boom truck to aid in removal.

Sparta July 4<sup>th</sup> parade will assemble at 9:30 at the jug handle to setup. At least one wagon is needed.

Fosterfield's Historic Farm was discussed; exhibits and activities will take place on Saturday, September 10<sup>th</sup>. They will make several acres available for plowing if wanted. They would appreciate a months notice on date and what we plan to displayed.

October 9<sup>th</sup> the Antique Truck Historical Society Show will be held at the Fairgrounds and would be good opportunity for the Club to open the shed to the public and possibly to display some tractors.

Additional tee shirts (70-75) were found with older screening impressions. They will be sold for same price as newer ones, for consistence and ease in selling.

Motion was made by Richard Muys Sr. to adjourn the meeting and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Brian Kardos..
