

#### The May 9th 2023 NJAE&MC INC. meeting was held at the SHED!

President, Chuck Klim, called the meeting to order, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The minutes were read from the last meeting by Secretary Sandy Betts.

Treasurer Linda Klim reported general and raffle bank account balances. The only bill requiring payment was to Bob Triebel for the club newsletter...payment was approved. The raffle doll for the State Fair & the Club's insurance have also been paid.

Linda gave an update on shirt orders and the embroidered shirts should be ready next week. Raffle tickets were discussed and it was proposed that *Minisink Press* do the printing as they could have them printed in two weeks. Printing business cards were also discussed, but it was decided they should be delayed until the club's website is properly established.

An open discussion followed regarding our website and getting ownership of it's domain and also the need to find someone to set it up, maintain it, download pictures, etc. A suggestion was made to contact Sussex County Vo-Tech for such a person.

There are 21 unpaid club members. Dues must be paid by June or their newsletter will be discontinued.

The sale of *Campbells Small Engines* to *Sussex County Rental Center* was mentioned and it was questioned whether SC Rental would continue advertising with our cart. The majority of the other advertising carts have been paid.

A Plow Days Event will be at *Wesselhoff Farms* on May 13<sup>th</sup> and Lenny at the farm asked if some tractors could be left for display until Sunday. *Sandyston's* parade is in August. Also, the *Fair Committee* has asked if the club could supply tractors during the *Boots Bourbon and BBQ fundraiser* being held June 10th

The shed addition plans have been approved by Harold Pellow (Fairgrounds) and permits will hopefully be approved by the Township next week. The need for a 24 inch post hole digger on a skid steer loader was mentioned and Brian Kardos said he could supply one.

Chuck requested again that someone step up to take the photographic responsibilities for the club, especially with the upcoming holiday parades.

Announcement was made that *Fosterfields* will be having their *Antique Tractor & Auto Day* on September 9th and need some tractors for display and plowing ...they were a "hit" in 2022!

Motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Blace Flatt and seconded by Bill Castimore.
