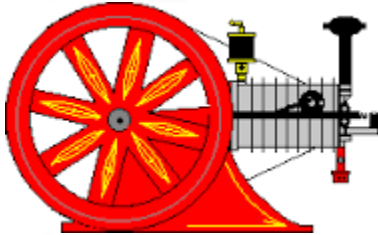

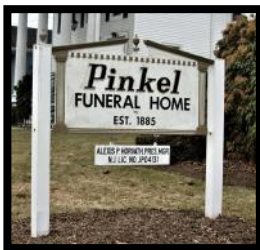
Brian Kardos Jr.
