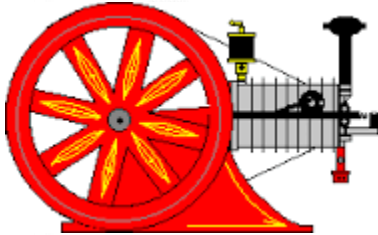

## **The September 13th meeting was held at the Shed, following the Pot-Luck-Picnic!**

President, Chuck Klim, called the meeting to order, followed by the flag salute.

Minutes were read from last month's meeting by Sandy Betts.

Treasurer, Linda Klim, reported general account and raffle account balances. Bills submitted by Bob Triebel, Chuck Klim, Blace Flatt and Bill Castimore were reviewed and approved for payment by the members attending.

Linda reported on expenses and earnings from the New Jersey State Fair. Total income from all sources was \$6, 536.00 with the bulk of the profit coming from (23) bags of peanut sold (as always) and significant income from the sale of brooms, shirts and hats. The (3) raffles, with 1224 tickets sold...produced dismal income and was a discussion topic of the meeting. NOTE: we have (5) bags of peanuts remaining, which should easily be sold at future events.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Linda Klim opened a discussion regarding cameras to surveil the shed. The shed had closed one evening during the Fair and she was working alone when two gentlemen entered, asking questions. She was able to dispatch them, but it left a question as to personal safety. The Fairgrounds have (16) outdoor cameras, but none inside buildings...a topic for the Fairground's next meeting. Linda has several of the type of camera needed and would like to donate them to the club. Installation of such equipment "and" the need to have more people, especially younger people, to help at the State Fair was a discussion topic.

Upcoming events were discussed: October 8<sup>th</sup> is Stillwater Day and 3-4 tractors are planning to attend, October 9<sup>th</sup> is a Truck & Tractor show at the Fairgrounds, October 21<sup>st</sup> is the Military Truck Show and October 29<sup>th</sup> is the Harvest, Honey & Garlic Day...also at the Fairgrounds. We have been asked to provide a tractor to pull wagons for hayrides. The shed will be open to the public on these days and we will sell peanuts and other merchandise.

Chuck Klim noted that Club Elections will be coming up in November, so if you are interested or want to nominate someone for office...this is the time.

The annual Christmas Party date was discussed and Wednesday, December 14, 2022 was chosen.

Motion was made to adjourn meeting by John Mackey and seconded by Brian Kardos.

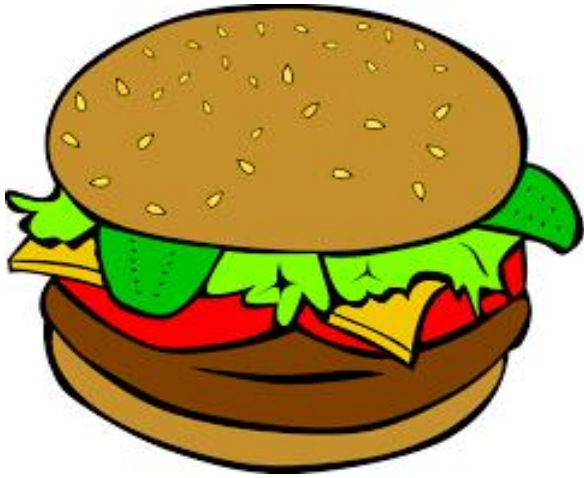
# Pot-Luck Picnic

Hamburgers and hotdogs were provided by the club and the many side dishes and deserts were provided by the members!



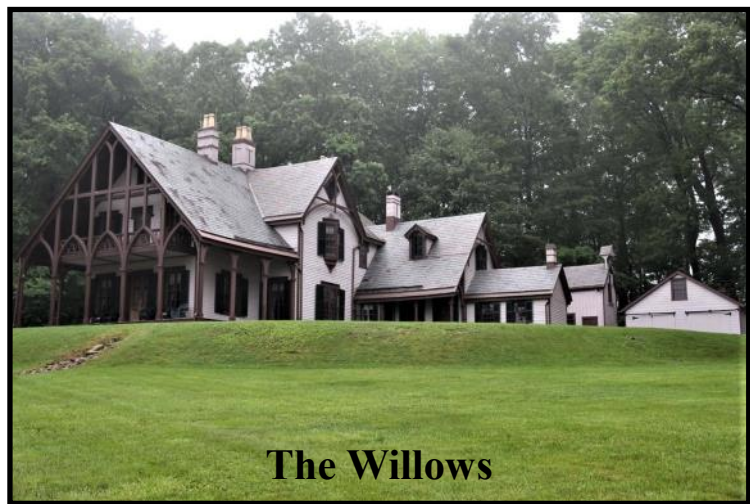


# FOSTERFIELDS LIVING HISTORICAL PARK

## ANTIQUE TRACTOR AND ENGINE DAY

September 10th 2022

This property has been a working farm since 1760. General Joseph Warren Revere, grandson of Paul Revere, bought the property in the mid-1800s and built the Gothic Revival home: called *The Willows*. Charles Foster purchased the farm in 1881, changing its name to **Fosterfields**. It was here that his daughter, Caroline Foster, lived 98 of her 102 years. In 1972, Ms. Foster donated Fosterfields to the *Morris County Park Commission*, to be preserved as a "living historical farm," the first in New Jersey.

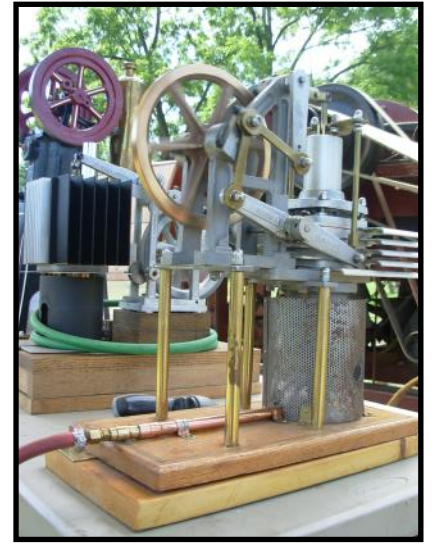
