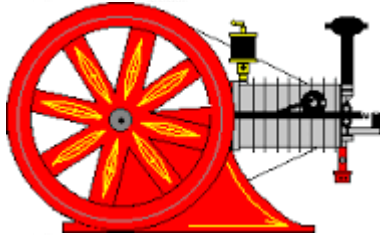

The September 3rd club meeting was held at the Fairgrounds Club shed.

President, Chuck Klim, called the meeting to order, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

July 30th club meeting minutes were read by Secretary, Sandy Betts.

Treasurer Linda Klim reported the general account balance at \$6,946.79 and raffle balance at \$3,700.00.

At the end of Fair week (259) tickets were sold for the quilt, \$777.00 , (260) Tractor tickets \$780.00; Peanuts \$ 3,052.00; Shirts \$400.00; Hats \$570.00; Brooms \$215.00; and Donations \$261.00.

Linda reported an error had been made in last month's bill for trailer paint purchased. The corrected amount was \$257.73 and \$215.64. This was then issued to the member. She also commented that the embroidered shirts should be ready in three to four weeks. The bill for electrical work done inside the shed still has not been received. Payment were made to Bob Triebel for the newsletter, \$61.68 and to Bill Castimore for epoxy for the Oil Field Engine, \$41.52.

A saddle that was raffled off at the Boots, Bourbon, Barbecue fundraiser was donated back to us, by the winner, to resell. It was commented that a blanket or bridle could be purchased to complete the ensemble.

It was voted and approved to honor Blace Flatt and Andy Mackey as lifetime members of the Club.

Gale Flatt has a large collections of period pieces that could be displayed in the shed. She also has a glass display cabinet, which she would sell for \$125.00 and It was motioned by John Mackey and seconded by Vinny Boutillette to purchase.

Vinny mentioned the outdoor shed contained a lot of inventory. It was discussed, rotating the contents into the main shed .

The Fairbanks and air compressor need antifreeze added.

It was discussed, setting up a table and tent for the Sussex County Day on September 15th and selling hats and shirts. A sign could be made to let attendees know peanuts would be sold in the shed.

Bob Triebel has physical problems that will not allow him to take Newsletter pictures in the future and Linda Klim offered to take pictures of our parades for the newsletter. It will also be delegated to other members to take pictures of other events.

The new tractor has been purchased for next year's raffle. It is battery powered and costs approximately \$320, far less than prior years.

The motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Brian Kardos and seconded by Jim LeDonne.

The annual picnic date was set for Saturday September 28th at noon.
