

The July 30th special club meeting was held at the Fairgrounds shed.

President, Chuck Klim, called the meeting to order, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The June 4th club meeting minutes were read by secretary, Sandy Betts.

Treasurer Linda Klim reported the general account balance at \$4,528.83 and the raffle account balance at \$4,497.92.

Money the Club made from Montague Day included: 51 bags of peanuts sold for \$102.00, one broom sold at \$25.00, two hats at \$30.00, and brownies and cupcakes sold for \$45.00.

The Club has received \$159.00 in donations.

The second peanut machine the Club purchased from Blace Flatt for \$3,800.00 was discussed by Linda as to whether it is still needed. A new motor has been ordered for the original machine. If the club were to sell the second machine it could possibly raise \$4,500.00. It was thought best to keep both machines through the Fair week and at the next meeting vote on whether to keep or sell the second machine.

Linda said, as director, she is looking for help in the Boots Bourbon and BBQ fundraiser. Tickets are \$75.00 and it is on August 24th, a Saturday, 5:00 to 10:00 PM.

It is the Club's 45th anniversary and Linda had the banners amended to show this.

Bills to be paid: Banners \$38.00; Peanuts \$1,250.00; kitchen renovations \$2,134.29; the kitchen electrical cost has yet to be submitted; July newsletter \$107.29; and \$25.10 and \$23.55 to paint the trailers.

Welding was completed on the Oil Field Engine's cast iron engine-block crack. Mike Insinga had to return four times to finish the job. He did not want payment, but the club decided to pay \$350.00 and give him a year's Club Membership.

Diesel fuel and a oil change is needed for Lister engine and to check fuel levels in the propane tanks for the Fair.

The motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Martin Little and seconded by Andy Mackey.


