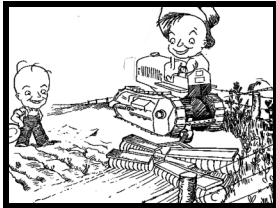

DENVILLE 100 YEAR ANNIVERSARY PARADE

June 9th



On Sunday June 9th, Denville did it again. Touted as the largest parade in the 100-year history of the “The Hub of Morris County,” an estimated 25 percent of Denville residents participated in the event. Local dignitaries waved to the crowd — Sen. Anthony Bucco sat in a vintage automobile with Rep. Rodney Frelinghuysen behind him in the rumble seat — while scout troops, police, firemen, the Denville Historical Society and many more civic groups marched behind.

Other organizations, including lake communities and local businesses, were represented by elaborate floats mounted on or towed by trucks. Animal lovers got a close look at a horse-drawn carriage and a genuine Clydesdale from Ort Farm, while a man, with the assistance of some amazing dogs, shepherded lambs right down Broadway.

Of note, the crowd was quite impressed to see the women of the North Jersey Antique Engine & Machine Club, Anne Marie Adams and Laura Squires, piloting “classic” tractors thru the Denville streets!

After the trek down Broadway, the parade continued on to Gardner Field for an all-day celebration with more entertainment, hot dogs and birch beer. Continuing centennial events include the opening of a time capsule buried during the 75th anniversary (a centennial time capsule will replace it), fireworks on July 4, a triathlon on August 11 at Cook’s Pond and a picnic on Sept. 22 at Gardner Field.

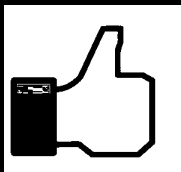
